REQUESTING STREAMING VIDEOS



Steps Faculty Can Take to Request Streaming Videos

- 1. After searching the catalog (a.k.a., Library Search) and determining we do not currently have a streaming film you want to assign: **contact** <u>your Subject Librarian</u> **to request it.**
 - a. Turnaround time for us to obtain streaming site license is approximately 1-10 business days depending on the distributor.
- 2. If we are able to obtain a streaming rights, we'll notify you and send you a link to the catalog record.
- 3. You have a few options for sharing streaming film with your students
 - a. You can share the link to the catalog record
 - b. You can click on the "View Now" button in the catalog which will take you to the vendor platform. From here you can find the embed code or proxied permalink (see reverse side of this handout for more information)
- 4. Contact your Campus' IT Help Desk for assistance with adding Library streaming videos into Sakai/Canvas.


