> While The Claremont Colleges Library primarily serves students and faculty of The Claremont Colleges, it also serves as an important center for learning, research and other related academic pursuits for all.


WHY VISIT THE CLAREMONT COLLEGES LIBRARY?

Options for Accessing The Claremont Colleges Library

GENERAL VISITORS (NO CARD REQUIRED)

- For those occasionally visiting to view exhibits, attend an event or stop by the Huntley Bookstore or Sanctuary Coffee, Campus
- Check in at the Main Services Desk or North Desk



COMMUNITY ACCESS CARD

- For frequent access to and use of Library spaces only (subject to blackout dates)
- Anyone is welcome to sign up for this *free* card at the Main Services Desk

COMMUNITY BORROWING CARD

- For access to Library spaces and to borrow Library materials (subject to blackout dates)
- Eligibility will determine whether a card is issued for free or for an annual fee; applications can be completed at the Main Services Desk
